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PART I – GENERAL

Article 1 – Purpose

§1. Introduction

This Cookie Policy explains how V1 uses cookies and similar technologies when you visit the official V1 website.

It should be read together with V1's Privacy Policy, which explains how personal data is collected, processed and protected.

§2. What Are Cookies?

Cookies are small text files that are placed on your computer, tablet or mobile device when you visit a website.

Cookies allow websites to function properly, improve user experience, remember preferences and collect analytical information regarding website usage.

Some cookies may also process personal data.

§3. Scope

This Cookie Policy applies exclusively to the V1 website and any related online services operated under the commercial name V1.

PART II – TYPES OF COOKIES

Article 2 – Categories of Cookies

§1. Strictly Necessary Cookies

Strictly necessary cookies are essential for the proper functioning and security of the website.

These cookies cannot be disabled through the website because they are required for basic website functionality.

Examples include:

- security cookies;
- session cookies;
- authentication cookies;
- cookie preference storage.

§2. Functional Cookies

Functional cookies allow the website to remember user preferences, such as language settings or previously selected options, in order to improve the browsing experience.

§3. Analytics Cookies

Analytics cookies help V1 understand how visitors use the website.

This information is used solely to improve website performance, user experience and the quality of the services offered.

Where required by law, analytics cookies shall only be placed after obtaining the visitor's consent.

§4. Marketing Cookies

Marketing cookies may be used to display relevant content or advertisements and to measure the effectiveness of marketing campaigns.

Marketing cookies shall only be placed after the visitor has provided explicit consent where required by applicable law.

PART III – COOKIE MANAGEMENT

Article 3 – Managing Cookie Preferences

§1. Consent

Upon your first visit to the V1 website, you will be presented with a cookie banner allowing you to:

- accept all cookies;
- reject non-essential cookies; or
- customise your cookie preferences.

Your preferences may be changed at any time through the cookie settings available on the website.

§2. Browser Settings

Most internet browsers allow cookies to be managed, restricted or deleted through the browser settings.

Disabling certain cookies may affect the functionality or performance of the website.

§3. Withdrawal of Consent

Where cookies are processed on the basis of consent, such consent may be withdrawn at any time without affecting the lawfulness of processing prior to withdrawal.

PART IV – THIRD-PARTY COOKIES

Article 4 – Third-Party Services

§1. Third-Party Technologies

Depending on the functionality available on the V1 website, cookies may be placed by trusted third-party providers, including for example:

- Microsoft;
- Google;
- YouTube;
- LinkedIn;
- Meta (Facebook and Instagram);
- embedded video providers;
- website analytics providers.

The use of such cookies remains subject to the privacy and cookie policies of the respective third-party providers.

§2. Future Technologies

As the V1 website evolves, additional third-party services may be integrated.

Where required by law, visitors shall be informed through an updated cookie policy and, where applicable, through the website's cookie management platform.

PART V – FINAL PROVISIONS

Article 5 – Amendments

§1. Changes

V1 reserves the right to amend this cookie policy where reasonably necessary to reflect:

- changes in legislation;
- changes to the website;
- technological developments;
- operational improvements;
- or changes in the cookies used.

§2. Publication

The latest version of this Cookie Policy shall always be available on the official V1 website.
